Corrie's House	Stillwater	To transform lives through trauma-informed care for young victims of sexual exploitation.
CSJ Ministries, Inc./Sara's Oasis	Saint Paul	To empower women through education and job training programs.  Sarah's Oasis empowers immigrant women to transition to complete self-sufficiency.
Dress for Success Twin Cities	Saint Paul	To empower women to achieve economic independence by providing a network of support, professional attire and the development tools to help women thrive in work and life.
Elevate Life	Bloomington	Provides financial grants to many of the 40 plus pregnancy centers and clinics, 14 of which are in the Twin Cities area, to assist them with providing programing which support women in choosing life for their preborn baby, preparing for the birth of their child, educating themselves on parenting and providing for their family.
Emerge Mothers Academy (EMA)	Minneapolis	To empower women to make positive choices for themselves and their families by providing a holistic approach to social support that includes work-preparation, social support, financial literacy education, parenting classes, mentoring, and a micro-loan grant initiative.
ESTHER Homes	Saint Paul	To aide pregnant women experiencing homelessness or crisis by providing maternity housing and access to resources for family stability within a community of support.
JCS Affective Sober Living	Minneapolis	Providing women with trauma informed care and a safe, sober, and supportive home environment as they transition from addiction and trauma into recovery, a more healthy lifestyle, and a better future.
Maria's Voice	Chaska	To create educational programs and collaborative partnerships that prevent domestic abuse and assert everyone's right to a Safe Home and Healthy, Equal Relationships.
Minnesota Perinatal Organization	Savage	To optimize perinatal health in Minnesota through education. They seek to improve perinatal and infant health outcomes with an emphasis on improving health equity for all birthing people.
Minnesota Prison Writing Workshop	Minneapolis	To foster a literary community and a devotion to art inside MN correctional facilities through high-quality creative writing classes and programming.
